POWERBALL TURNS 30



Powerball, America's Game, is celebrating 30 years of making millionaires! Powerball started April 19, 1992, with a starting jackpot of \$2 million. On July 21, 1994, Powerball became the first Lotto game offered by the new Nebraska Lottery. It continues to be Nebraska's favorite Lotto game.

Over the years, hundreds of millionaires have been created across the county by playing Powerball. This includes 10 Powerball jackpot winners and 26 \$1 million winners here in the Nebraska. Ticket sales have helped to generate over \$868 million for good causes across Nebraska.

To commemorate the Powerball 30th Anniversary, the Nebraska Lottery is offering a special promotion. Between April 18 and April 20, free Powerball Power Play tickets will be randomly produced with Powerball purchases. The lottery terminal will sound and a trailer ticket will print following the purchased ticket each time the promotion is triggered.

When a free ticket is produced at your store, make sure to explain the promotion to the player and give them the free ticket. The promotion will end at midnight on April 20, 2022.

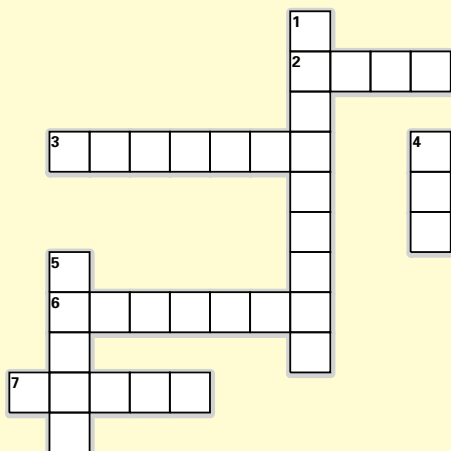

RETAILER SPOTLIGHT

NORM'S ON 48TH



Sometimes when you stop to fill up the tank with gas, you'll stop inside to fill up your stomach. A bag of chips, maybe, a couple of Slim Jims or a couple of donuts to fight off the hangries. Sometimes that's not enough. Sometimes you just need a big plate of barbecue.

There's a place in Lincoln that has all the c-store staples and then some. Offering freshly smoked pulled pork sandwiches, burgers and more, Norm's on 48th is home to some of the tastiest food in town served

only for a few hours a day. In fact, this gas station and convenience store was named third best burger in Lincoln last year.

Dennis and Stacey Sell bought Norm's about two and a half years ago. Dennis runs Norm's Car Care at 40th and A streets in Lincoln and needed to expand. The current store came on the market and featured a decent auto shop space, so they decided to buy it.

Offering gas and a convenience store was kind of a second thought originally, but it quickly became one of the more unique stores in town, and not just for their food offerings.

Directly above the Red Bulls and Gatorades, the front end of an early 1950s Chevy Deluxe hangs over a ledge. Its big, shiny chrome grill and bumpers are a little banged up, but it looks like it would still be up for some racing.

Instead of a beer cave, Norm's has a beer garage, featuring beer, as well as wine and liquor. Don't see anything you like? Norm's takes requests on a dry-erase board next to the displays.

And they've got plans to do add a few more fun features down the line.

"We've still got a lot to go," Dennis said, "but it's getting closer and closer and closer."

Norm's sells lots of locally-made treats. From sweet desserts like High Society Cheesecake, Randy's Donuts Shop, and Lincoln-made ice cream to somewhat more savory fare from Lincoln's own A-Maize-N Popcorn & Snacks.

Around back there's a 500-gallon propane tank retrofitted into a massive smoker by a company in Texas. The Sell's son Tyler runs the smoker and puts out pulled pork and smash burgers at an incredible rate.

On weekdays they'll sell over 100 pulled pork sandwiches and just as many burgers. They're only served from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., but there's always the 100 to 200 breakfast burritos they sell in the mornings.

"We really kind of just jumped into it," Stacey said. "I don't even remember why he started making burritos, and then I started doing the walking tacos and it just kind of snowballed from there."

Only on Fridays, Norm's offers its most popular items, a burger with pork belly burnt ends on top. Those go flying out the door, Stacy said, and when they're gone, they're gone.

"Come early," she said.

Norm's on 48th is located at 2510 S 48th Street in Lincoln and is open from 6 a.m. through 9 p.m. seven days a week.
