### \$50,000 Royal 7's Prize for Bruning Woman

While claiming her prize on March 2. Fowler told Nebraska Lottery officials that she didn't realize she had won the \$50,000 prize at first after scratching the ticket. "I thought it was worth \$50," said Fowler. "I was shocked when I checked the ticket again and saw the \$50,000." She plans to pay bills using her winnings.

Royal 7's was a \$5 Scratch game from the Nebraska Lottery that offered players the chance to win \$1,020,000 in cash prizes from \$5 to \$50,000. The odds of winning \$50,000 playing Royal 7's were 1 in 100,000, while the overall odds of winning any prize were 1 in 3.59.

## HEN GAMBLING BECOMES A BAD BET.....

Gambling is a recreational activity enjoyed by the majority of adults in Nebraska. There are some, however, for whom gambling is more than recreational and is in fact addictive and destructive. The devastation to the gambler and their family is well documented. What is less known is how families can protect themselves from the devastation of gambling and the gambler.

"When you know more about the warning signs, you can take personal action or help a friend or relative who's affected by problem gambling," said Scot Adams, director of the Division of Behavioral Health in the Department of Health and Human Services.

You may have a gambling problem if

- Gamble for longer than you intended:
- Borrow money to gamble;
- Lie about how much you gambled;
- · Bet more than you intended.

"Problem gambling affects the emotional, physical and financial wellness of individuals and their families and impacts every aspect of society," Adams said.

"The good news is that people don't have to wait to 'hit rock bottom' before asking for help," Adams said. "We know that through awareness, education and, if necessary, treatment services, we can prevent further problem gambling issues for Nebraskans.'

Treatment for problem gambling is not only available, but is also effective in improving the lives of problem gamblers and their families. The Gamblers Assistance Program (GAP) was established in 1992. Since that time, the GAP has worked to assist those negatively affected by problem gambling. The GAP contracts with individuals throughout Nebraska to provide treatment services to problem gamblers and their family members. The Nebraska Lottery has provided over \$9.4 million dollars in lottery proceeds to the Gamblers Assistance Program since 1993.
