## \$50,000 Royal 7's Prize for Bruning Woman

Trisha Fowler of Bruning won \$50,000 playing the \$5 Scratch game Royal 7's from the Nebraska Lottery.

Fowler purchased her winning Royal 7's ticket at Bruning Food Mart, 6206 Spur 85C in Bruning. Scratching the ticket, she revealed one winning "7" symbol with a corresponding prize of \$50,000.



There were three \$50,000 top prizes available in Royal 7's. Fowler was the third person to claim a top prize in the game.

While claiming her prize on March 2, Fowler told Nebraska Lottery officials that she didn't realize she had won the \$50,000 prize at first after scratching the ticket. "I thought it was worth \$50," said Fowler. "I was shocked when I checked the ticket again and saw the \$50,000." She plans to pay bills using her winnings.

Royal 7's was a \$5 Scratch game from the Nebraska Lottery that offered players the chance to win \$1,020,000 in cash prizes from \$5 to \$50,000. The odds of winning \$50,000 playing Royal 7's were 1 in 100,000, while the overall odds of winning any prize were 1 in 3.59.

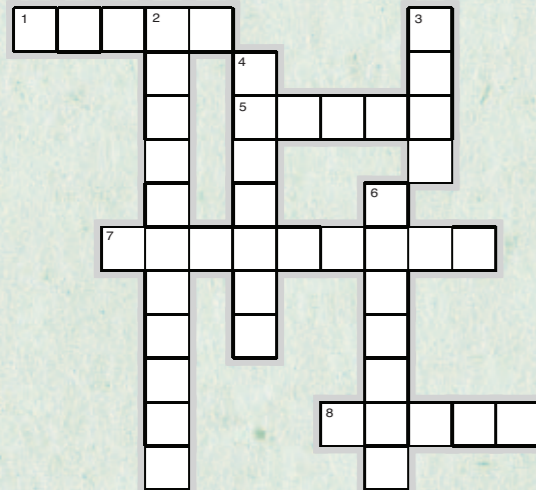
