# **Nebraska NASCAR Powerball Playoff Contestant Wins \$5,000**



Joseph Medina of Franklin was the Nebraska Lottery's finalist for the 2023 NASCAR Powerball Playoff promotion. While he didn't win the grand prize, he is taking home \$5,000.

He advanced from the first round of 15 Nebraska Lottery winners, who each took home \$1,000. Joseph made it to the national

round of 16 semi-finalists from around the country.

On September 16, at the Bass Pro Shops Night Race at Bristol Motor Speedway, broadcasters announced that Joseph had made it to the next round, along with 11 other contestants.

Sadly, he didn't make it through to the next round, but still got to walk away with a \$5,000 prize.

There are still two more rounds of finalists. The next one, to be announced on October 29 at the Xfinity 500, will send four contestants on the grand prize trip.

The winners will travel to Phoenix for a three night stay during the NASCAR Cup Series Championship on November 5. They'll get to attend the race, go behind the scenes at the track and one person out of the four will win

Even though he's out of the running for the grand prize, we're thrilled Joseph got as far as he did.

### **New Scratch Pack Sizes**

Starting in January, the number of tickets in \$10 and \$20 Scratch ticket packs will be changing. \$10 ticket packs will increase to 40 tickets for a total value of \$400. \$20 ticket packs will increase to 30 tickets with a total value of \$600.

The first Scratch games with the new pack sizes will be \$10 High Voltage and \$20 Colossal Crossword. These games are scheduled to launch January 22. There will be a period when games with the old and new pack sizes will both be on sale. \$10 and \$20 games will have a sticker attached to them with the pack value for reference.

If a player brings in a Scratch or Lotto ticket with a damaged barcode that can't be scanned, you can still pay your customer by manually validating the ticket.

To manually validate a ticket, touch Validation on the lottery terminal, then touch Scratch Validation or Lotto Validation. For Scratch tickets, enter the 14-digit game, pack, and ticket number from the back of the ticket AND the 14-digit VIRN number under the latex on the front of the ticket. For a Lotto ticket, enter the 19-digit ticket number.

If you are still unable to validate the ticket, instruct the player to send in the ticket to the prize claim address on the back of the ticket.

## **Black Friday and Holiday Specials**

Two new Lotto specials are coming up in November and December.

The Black Friday Special will run November 22 to 26. A "Special" button will appear on your terminal that will produce quick pick plays for Nebraska Pick 3, Nebraska Pick 5, and MyDaY at a discounted price of \$2.

Another promotion will run in December. The Holiday Lotto Special will run December 11 to 22, offering a 2by2, MyDaY, and Nebraska Pick 3 ticket of \$2.

If the "Special" button does not appear on your terminal during these promotions, sign off then sign back in. If the button still does not show, reboot the terminal.


