Our events team traveled to fairs and festivals across the state nearly every week from June through August and will cap off their summer activities at the Nebraska State Fair from August 25 thru September 4. Our trailer will be parked along State Fair Boulevard and we will be there from open to close each day.

Our Scratch and Lotto sales continue to move along with the help of all our retailer partners. With production delays, we had to delay the release of our 2023 Truck\$ & Buck\$ tickets. As of this writing, we still have 6 trucks to give away. We are also coming off the excitement of the \$1.58 billion Mega Millions jackpot that gave sales a bump.

We hope fall 2023 will be just as productive as summer was.





Dueling Jackpots Bring Excitement for Players

Record Powerball and Mega Millions jackpot runs brought excitement to players and retailers this summer.

The jackpot runs started in mid-April. After 38 drawings, the Powerball jackpot climbed to \$1.08 billion for the July 19 drawing. One jackpot-winning ticket was sold in California, and six \$50,000 prizes and one \$100,000 Power Play prize were won in Nebraska during the entire jackpot run.

May 13: \$50,000 Powerball winning ticket sold at Casey's #2716, 1610 Colfax Street in Schuyler.

May 15: \$50,000 Powerball winning ticket sold at Bakers #321, 505 N 155th Plaza in Omaha.

June 3: \$50,000 Powerball winning ticket sold at Kum & Go #378, 14353 Q Street in Omaha.

June 10: \$50,000 Powerball winning ticket sold at Westco - KC's Short Stop, 2420 Box Butte Avenue in Alliance.

June 19: \$50,000 Powerball winning ticket sold at Hy-Vee Fast & Fresh #2, 1515 N 84th Street in Lincoln.

July 12: \$50,000 Powerball winning ticket sold at Kum & Go #348, 12011 Blondo Street in Omaha.

July 19: \$100,000 Powerball Power Play winning ticket sold at Cornhusker Quick Stop, 10209 S 25th Street in Bellevue.

The Mega Millions jackpot continued to climb after the Powerball jackpot was won. After 31 drawings the Mega Millions jackpot had reached \$1.58 million for the August 8 drawing - the highest jackpot ever in the game. One jackpot-winning ticket was sold in Florida. Four \$10,000 prizes and one \$1 million prize were won in Nebraska during the entire jackpot run.

April 25: \$10,000 Mega Millions winning ticket sold at Speedee Mart 2855, 1220 N 1st Street in Norfolk.

May 30: \$10,000 Mega Millions winning ticket sold at Speedee Mart 2730, 4334 S 84th Street in Omaha.


June 30: \$10,006 Mega Millions winning ticket sold at Main St Market, 401 So. Beltline Hwy. W. in Scottsbluff.

July 7: \$10,000 Mega Millions winning ticket sold at Baker's #323 Fuel Center, 1615 N Bell Street in Fremont.

August 4: \$1 million Mega Millions winning ticket sold at Oakland Express Fuels, 909 Hwy 32 in Oakland.

Multiple Validation Attempts

Have you ever scanned a ticket only to have the lottery terminal report it was "Previously Cashed By This Retailer"? It's a common scenario, and we'll show you how to complete the transaction for the customer.

Often the Previously Cashed message appears when a ticket is scanned multiple times in succession. This is because scanning winning tickets with prizes of \$25 or less results in an automatic validation.

To prevent double-scanning when validating tickets, wait a second or two for the validation message to come up after scanning a ticket. If you do not get a response after two seconds, then it is okay to scan again.

If you have a previously cashed ticket, your store has received credit for the validation, and you should pay the player. You can review the last transactions to see how much the ticket was validated for. Touch the Last Transactions button, then touch Last Transaction to check if the transaction was successfully completed and the value of the last validation. The last 50 transactions can also be accessed there if needed.

Nebraska Pick 5 **Enhancements**



Nebraska's game Nebraska Pick 5 is getting an upgrade on August 13, 2023. Two numbers will be added, so players will select five numbers between 1 and 40 to play. Matching four of the five winning numbers will win \$500 instead of \$450. And every time the jackpot is not won it will increase by \$10,000. The odds of winning the jackpot will be 1 in 658,008, while the overall odds will be 1 in 9.2.

Retailer Spotlight

About halfway between Norfolk and Interstate 29, Oakland Express Fuels seems like the perfect place to take a break before that stretch of endless highway. For one Ohio trucker, a stop for some hot food and a drink at Oakland Express was worth \$1 million.



The store opened in 2019 and has been a must-stop for truckers and travelers alike. Locals pop into the restaurant attached to the convenience store, keeping them busy over lunch and dinner. There's even a tiny hotel for sleepy truckers and travelers.

It's got just about anything you'd want in a pit stop. And for that reason, it's become a regular stop for Byron Eash, a long-haul truck driver from North Lewisburg, Ohio.

Every Thursday, Eash picks up a load in Norfork and hits the road and always makes one important stop, Oakland Express.

"I always stop there to grab something to eat, something cold to drink and to check my straps," he said. "Then I'm good to go."

On August 3, Eash made his regular stop at Oakland Express and saw the Mega Millions jackpot was getting pretty high. He's not much of a Lotto player usually, he said, but the big jackpots draw him in.

He bought a couple of tickets from clerk Spencer Herbolsheimer and headed back on the road to Ohio. He was still on the road when he found out he'd won.

A buddy of his, from the Oakland area, who he'd stopped with also bought some tickets at the same time. His friend heard there was a big winner around the time he'd bought his tickets and, after realizing he wasn't the \$1 million winner, he figured it must have been Eash.

"He called me up and said, 'you won on Powerball," Eash said. "It was Mega Millions, so I had a little fun and told him I didn't win Powerball."

Word traveled quickly through Oakland that there'd been a \$1 million winner. Nobody from town had a winning ticket, so owner Michelle Herbolsheimer took a look at the security footage for August 3 at 2:28 p.m.

"We knew who it was right away," she said. They didn't have an immediate way of contacting Eash, but he knew he'd be back in just a few days.

"It's a small town and everybody was like, 'Did you check your ticket," Herbolsheimer said. "I posted about the win on Facebook and I think there were 30,000 views by Sunday. We had people from out of state calling and couldn't believe it was sold in Oakland."

Herbolsheimer said they'd been trying to find ways to boost their lottery sales, and the win worked pretty well. She said people who'd heard about the win were stopping at their store to see if some of the luck might rub off on them.

Eash started heading back toward Nebraska and stopped at the Nebraska Lottery's Lincoln offices on Wednesday, August 9 to claim his prize.

He said the big win wasn't going to change much about his trucking routine and he'd definitely keep up one tradition.

"I'll be stopping in Oakland," he said. "I always do."
