totaling \$18,460,996, and in 2004, the Legislature directed that a one-time transfer of \$5 million be made to the State General Fund.

With the end of our fiscal year on June 30, I have the pleasure of reporting our total sales for the previous twelve months. While calculations won't be considered "final" until this fall when our annual audit is completed, the likely total sales figure for Fiscal Year 2008-2009 will be \$123 million. The total for Fiscal Year 2007-2008 was \$122 million.

The fact that this year's figure is an increase from the previous year is a testament to the public's recognition of the work we're doing together—Helping To Build A Better Nebraska.


