

WINNING WAYS

Third Ford F-150 Claimed by Ashton Man



Michael Kosmicki of Ashton is the third winner of a 2010 Ford F-150 XLT Super Crew 4x4 Flex Fuel truck in the 15th edition of the Nebraska Lottery's \$2 Truck\$ & Buck\$ Scratch game.

Kosmicki recently purchased his winning Truck\$ & Buck\$ ticket at Trotter Whoa & Go Express in Loup City. Scratching the ticket, he revealed three "TRUCK" symbols in Game 2 for the corresponding truck prize.

There are four Ford F-150 trucks available in Truck\$ & Buck\$. Kosmicki is the third person to claim a top prize truck to date.

Nebraska Lottery officials presented Kosmicki with his prize on Tuesday, July 27, at Trotter Whoa & Go. During the presentation, he told Nebraska Lottery officials that he purchased his winning ticket after cashing in some tickets at the store. "I bought three Truck\$ & Buck\$ tickets

and scratched them off at the counter," said Kosmicki. "The third one was the truck winner." Kosmicki said that he was "very happy" to win the truck prize.

The 15th edition of the Nebraska Lottery's popular Truck\$ & Buck\$ Scratch game features the 2010 Ford F-150 XLT Super Crew 4x4 Flex Fuel truck as its top prize. Players have the opportunity to win one of four Ford F-150 trucks as well as \$741,000 in cash and Ethanol-enriched fuel prizes. The truck prize is valued at \$50,000, which includes \$1,465 for costs associated with ownership and state and federal withholding paid by the Nebraska Lottery of \$2,500 and \$12,500, respectively. The odds of winning the top prize in Truck\$ & Buck\$ are 1 in 180,000, while the overall odds of winning any prize are 1 in 3.53.

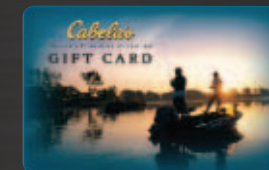

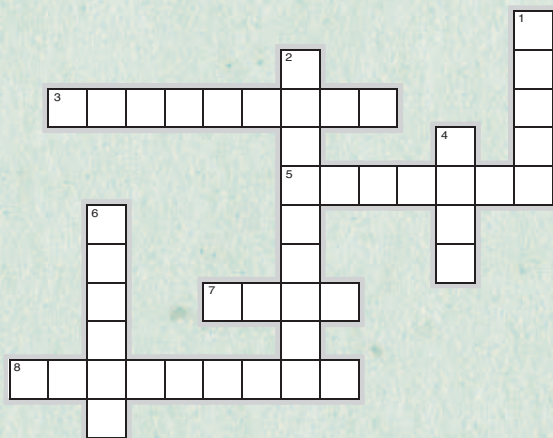

GIFT GIVING

Nebraska Lottery Tickets Make Great Gifts, If You're At Least 19.

Throughout the year, the Nebraska Lottery suggests tickets as a gift option for those hard-to-buy-for individuals on your list.

Lottery Director Jim Haynes has something to add to that: "We always encourage players to play responsibly, and we ask them to give responsibly as well. Nebraska Lottery tickets are a great gift idea, but they should only be given to recipients who are at least 19 years of age."

The Nebraska Lottery sells \$1, \$2, \$3, \$5, \$10, and \$15 Scratch tickets, and offers Lotto games such as Powerball, 2by2,

Nebraska Pick 5, Nebraska Pick 3, MyDaY, and Mega Millions. By law, Nebraska Lottery tickets may only be purchased and redeemed by persons who are 19 years or older.

Haynes noted that each ticket, whether Scratch or Lotto, carries the minimum age (19) reminder, and the same message appears on all in-store signage as well as in broadcast and print advertising. "No matter how clever or attractive a game may be, it should only be given to individuals who are of legal age to play," said Haynes.

Claim Center Hours Changing

Beginning October 18, the Nebraska Department of Revenue offices in Norfolk, North Platte, and Scottsbluff will be open from 8:00 a.m. to Noon, Monday through Friday. Nebraska Lottery prizes may be

claimed at the Regional Lottery Claim Centers in these locations during these hours. Additionally, prizes may be claimed via mail by sending a completed claim form to:

Prizes may be claimed at the Omaha Regional Lottery Claim Center and at Nebraska Lottery headquarters in Lincoln between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Prizes of \$20,000 or more must be claimed in person at Nebraska Lottery headquarters in Lincoln.

Nebraska Lottery Announces Chiefs Cash Fantasy Scratch Game

The Nebraska Lottery has released its latest \$5 Scratch game featuring one of the most recognized professional football teams in America—the Kansas City Chiefs.

With a look inspired by the gridiron, the \$5 Chiefs Cash Fantasy Scratch game features an extended play style and 16 chances to win on each ticket. Players have the opportunity to win over \$1.1 million in total cash prizes from \$5 to \$30,000. Additionally, the multiplier feature allows prizes won to be multiplied three or seven times.

A drawing will be held on December 1 to select one Top Prize winning entry and four Second-Tier Prize winning entries. The Top Prize winner will receive Two Founder's Suite game tickets, a Chiefs prize package, \$500 cash, and \$100 in Nebraska Lottery Scratch tickets. Second

Prize winners will receive four upper level game tickets, pre-game sideline passes, a Chiefs prize package, \$500 cash, and \$100 in Nebraska Lottery Scratch tickets.

The final promotion for the Chiefs Cash Fantasy game will be held in December.
