John Grimes of Alliance recently won \$1 million playing Powerball Power Play from the Nebraska Lottery. Grimes is a regular Nebraska Lottery player who purchases Power-

ball Power Play tickets each week at J&J Pit Stop, 1308 West 3rd Street in Alliance. For the September 29 Powerball drawing, he purchased a quick pick ticket that matched all five of the winning white ball numbers (13, 44, 51, 52, 55) for \$200,000.

Because Grimes added the \$1 Power Play option to his purchase, his \$200,000 prize was automatically multiplied by the 5x multiplier for a total of \$1 million.

While claiming his prize on October 22. Grimes told Nebraska Lottery officials that he usually plays the same Powerball numbers each week, but decided to add a quick pick ticket

for the September 29 draw to his regular purchase. He learned he had won after hearing the winning numbers on the Nebraska Lottery Players Hotline (800-224-LUCK). "I told my wife, 'I think I've got it," said Grimes. He plans to save for retirement using his winnings.



# CHOLARSHIP FUND **HEELS**

Among the various efforts funded by Nebraska Lottery proceeds is the Nebraska Opportunity Grant Fund, which is administered by the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education under the Nebraska Opportunity Grant Act.

With the help of the Nebraska Lottery, the Nebraska Opportunity Grant Act has been able to award more than 78,000 Nebraska Opportunity Grants to college students at dozens of Nebraska institutions.

Grants were made to 15,704 students during the 2009-10 Academic Year. With grants averaging \$897, a total of \$14,093,053 was distributed to students attending 42 different institutions of higher education in Nebraska.

Among the students who received 2009-10 grants, 10,322 attended a public institution; 2,884 attended an independent college or university; and 2,498 attended a private for profit institution.

Grants were made to 14,106 students during the 2008-09 Academic Year. With grants averaging \$868, a total of \$12.241.846 was distributed to students attending 43 different institutions of 2008-09), the State of Nebraska General higher education in Nebraska.

Grants were made to 13.158 students during the 2007-08 Academic Year. With grants averaging \$944, a total of \$12,421,824 was distributed to students attending 43 different institutions of higher education in Nebraska.

Grants were made to 11,860 students during the 2006-07 Academic Year. With grants averaging \$876, a total of \$10.388.223 was distributed to students attending 43 different institutions of higher education in Nebraska.

Grants were made to 13,609 students during the 2005-06 Academic Year. With grants averaging \$729, a total of \$9,917,594 was distributed to students attending 43 different institutions of higher education in Nebraska.


Schools select students as potential recipients, and the Coordinating Commission for Post-Secondary Education approves the students and distributes funds to the institutions. Grants are made based on financial need, and students are not guaranteed to receive the grant every year they are enrolled.

The Nebraska Opportunity Grant Fund uses a blend of funding from the United States Department of Education's LEAP/SLEAP program (4 percent in Fund (53 percent in 2008-09), and Nebraska Lottery proceeds (43 percent in 2008-09).

Nebraska Lottery proceeds are being used in many ways to help people and projects across our state, supporting efforts focused on areas such as education, the environment, compulsive gamblers assistance, and the Nebraska State Fair. So far. \$395 million has been raised for Nebraska Lottery beneficiary funds.
