The Nebraska Environmental Trust grant for conservation of bighorn habitat. was established in 1992 to conserve, enhance, and restore the natural environments
of Nebraska. It was created on the convicion that a prosperous future is dependen upon a sound natural environment and that Nebraskans could collectively achieve real seed money was provided.

Here are a few projects supported by he Nebraska Environmental Trust using Lottery proceeds:
Sowbelly Ranch: Helping to conserve a Pine Ridge jewel
In December 2015, Jim and Chris Voeller, the owners of the Sowbelly Ranch, a stunningly beautiful 1,304 -acre section of the Sowbelly Canyon north of Harrison, Nebraska, permanently conserved the land
through a conservation easement with the Nebraska Land Trust. The Voellers especially wanted to protect the habitat their ranch provides for elk and bighorn sheep. With limited funds to purchase the easement, the Voellers generously offered to donate more than half of the easement's less than half the appraised value. The Nebraska Environmental Trust, which receives $44.5 \%$ of state lottery proceeds, provided most of the balance through a

declined drastically since the settlement of the Great Plains," said TJ Fontaine, assistant unit leader of the Nebraska Cooperative Fish \& Wildlife Research Unit. Locating these beautiful animals and gathering information on their ecological and geographical distributions is essential students in the Nebraska Canid Project travel to the privately owned land of friends and family to set up cameras in an attempt to find and document swift foxes.
