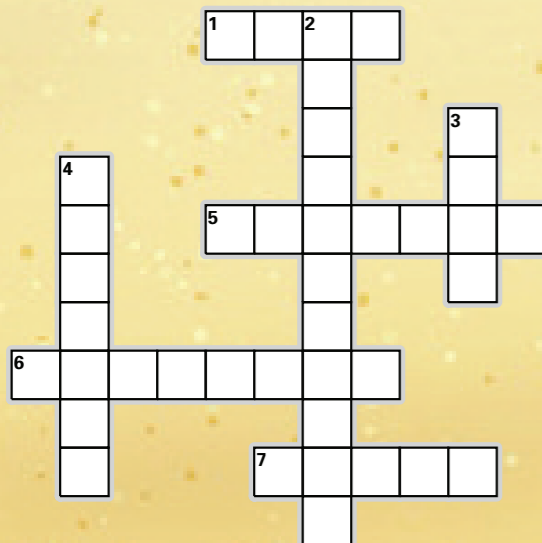

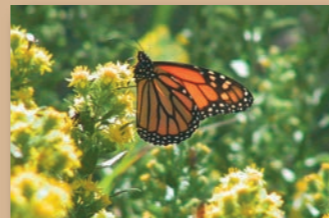

Preserving Natural Nebraska™



In continuing efforts to help the declining monarch butterfly population, the Save Our Monarchs Foundation (SOM), through a grant from the Nebraska Environmental Trust, is providing online instruction on monarch butterflies for youth and their parents and delivering pollinator plant plugs to families interested in creating pollinator gardens at home.

As part of its partnership with the Omaha Public Power District (OPPD), and their 'Prairies in Progress' program to restore district properties to pollinator habitat, SOM had planned to provide classroom instruction in schools throughout the district's footprint this spring, as well as planting pollinator gardens at schoolyards. Given the coronavirus pandemic and subsequent school closings, the foundation has decided to provide the classroom program free of charge online through its YouTube channel ([youtube.com/watch?v=OOt8QRwPx6E](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OOt8QRwPx6E)). These short, instructional videos are accessible to the public, and provide information on Monarchs, their migration, lifecycle, and needs, along with tips for how to help. Instead of planting gardens in schoolyards, SOM is soliciting requests for plugs from students in the Omaha metro area interested in creating pollinator gardens in their own yards. The foundation is also encouraging gardeners to submit photographs and videos of their pollinator gardens to their Facebook page ([facebook.com/saveourmonarchs](https://www.facebook.com/saveourmonarchs)) to share with others.

Habitat for Monarchs makes excellent habitat for other vital and diminishing species, including native bees and migratory birds. Such habitat consists of bio-diverse landscapes that contain milkweed (the monarch caterpillar's only food

source) and other native nectar and pollen sources that SOM is providing to the public free of charge. "Gardening for Monarchs and other pollinators is a perfect stay-at-home activity that the whole family can enjoy, all while helping provide much needed breeding habitat for the arriving Monarchs on their journey north," said Jenn Duerr, Outreach Coordinator for SOM.

These efforts are part of SOM's Corridors for Pollinators (CFP) program, which works with utility companies and other right-of-way holders to manage properties as pollinator habitat while also taking care of business and regulatory needs. To date the program has helped restore or enhance over 15,000 acres since beginning in 2015, and this year will provide over 4,000 pollinator plant plugs to help establish quality pollinator habitat throughout the state. "The scientific research is in, we need more habitat," says Ward Johnson, Executive Director of the foundation. The group is working on the eastern migratory flyway that extends from the 100th parallel running through Nebraska to the eastern seaboard of Canada, the United States and Mexico. Randall Gilbert, the group's program director, says "We are really a group of concerned citizens and activists focused on getting plants that benefit Monarchs and other pollinators in the ground and increasing habitat. We are unceasingly passionate about this work."

An update to the Nebraska Lottery mobile app has added some great new features.

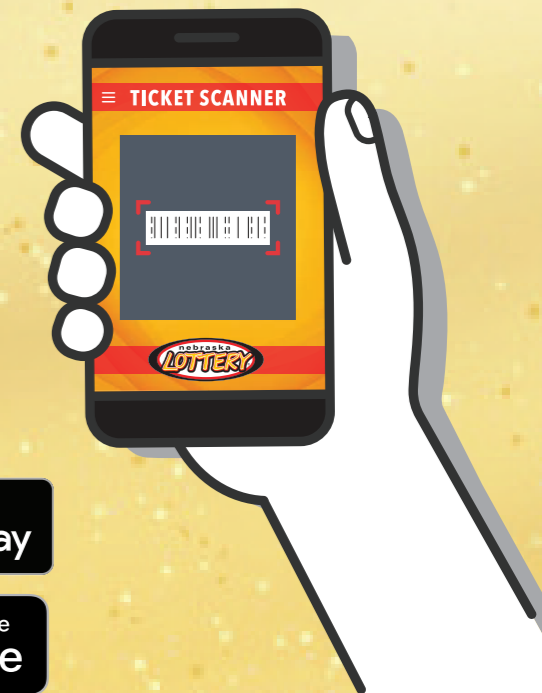
Scan your Scratch and Lotto tickets with the new Ticket Scanner and cut down on trips to check tickets at retailers. Just open the Nebraska Lottery app and scan the ticket barcode just like the Check-A-Ticket device at stores.

New notification options in the app allow you to receive information about games and promotion on your device. In addition to jackpot alerts, you can be notified when new Scratch games are

launched. You can also be notified when new MVP Club promotions begin at nelottery.com.

In addition to these new features, you can still get the latest winning Lotto numbers, find local retailers, and learn about Lottery beneficiary projects within the app.

Kimball Man Wins \$280,000 Playing Nebraska Pick 5



Brian Pearson of Kimball won \$280,000 playing Nebraska Pick 5 from the Nebraska Lottery.

Pearson bought his winning ticket at Vince's Corner at 100 E 3rd Street in Kimball. The ticket matched the winning numbers 04, 07, 11, 13 and 29 from the March 28 drawing.

When Pearson claimed his prize at the Nebraska Lottery's Lincoln offices, he said he'd heard through word of mouth that there had been a big winner in Kimball. When he checked his ticket and saw he'd won, he was in shock.

Pearson said he chose his numbers in honor of his wife who died a few years ago. He played her birth date as well as the date when she died.

"She's my guardian angel," he said.

The odds of winning the Nebraska Pick 5 jackpot, which starts at \$50,000 and grows by \$4,000 each drawing that is not won, are 1 in 501,942 while the overall odds of winning a prize in the game, which has drawings seven nights a week, are 1 in 8.
