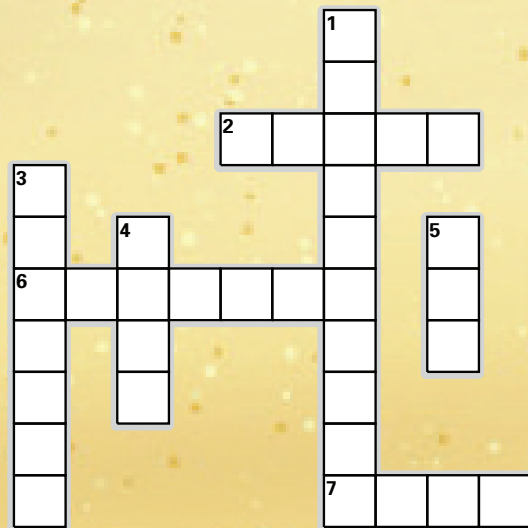

Lottery Proceeds Support the Nebraska State Fair

Did you know that when you buy a Nebraska Lottery ticket, you're helping the Nebraska State Fair?

In 2004, a constitutional amendment added the State Fair as a Lottery beneficiary and directed 10 percent of lottery proceeds to the Fair each year. A total of \$63.9 million has been transferred to date.

That funding has allowed the Nebraska State Fair to continue as a premier event for all Nebraskans. Lottery funds are used for ongoing building maintenance and to expand offerings at the Fair.

These proceeds are crucial, because unlike most states, Nebraska does not own its fairgrounds. Rental income from other events throughout the year can't be used to operate the State Fair.

"Nebraska Lottery proceeds are very important for us," said Bill Ogg, Nebraska State Fair Executive Director. "Those funds support our mission to continue the traditions of the Fair and provide new educational and entertaining experiences for all."

Lottery proceeds helped pay for the 2015 construction of the Nebraska Building, a 4,000-square-foot climate-controlled space that houses Raising Nebraska, a must see year-round interactive ag education display operated by the University of Nebraska, Nebraska Game and Parks Fair exhibits, and State Fair Administrative Offices. The Fair office also serve as a Regional Lottery Claim Center where players can claim prizes up to \$19,999.

The 2022 Nebraska State Fair runs August 26 – September 5 in Grand Island. There is Nothing More Nebraskan! Visit statefair.org to plan your visit. While you're at the Fair, make sure to look for the Nebraska Lottery trailer for prizes, fun, and your chance to support good causes across Nebraska.

La Vista Woman Wins \$58,000 Playing Nebraska Pick 5



Jean Pierson of La Vista won \$58,000 playing Nebraska Pick 5 from the Nebraska Lottery.

Pierson purchased her ticket at Speedee Mart 2760 at 100 W Centennial Rd. in Papillion. The ticket contained one play for 35 days of Nebraska Pick 5 drawings, one of which matched the April 13 winning numbers 05, 06, 09, 10 and 30.

Pierson and her husband Rob Pierson have been daily players for the past couple of years and they always replay the same five numbers.

The Piersons only check their tickets when it's time to buy another set of plays, so their April 13 win went undiscovered until May 7.

While pulling into the parking lot to check their ticket and grab a new one, Rob said, "Somebody's gotta win, why not us?"

When the clerk scanned her ticket, her mouth dropped to the floor, Pierson said.

"I was shaking so bad," she said. "She had me sign the back of the ticket right away."

Pierson said she usually jokes with the clerk when she checks her ticket, asking them if they'll have someone from security to escort them with their millions. This time she almost wished she did have someone watching out for her.

The ticket went into hiding right away when they got home and Pierson wouldn't even tell her kids where she hid it. She did tell Rob who had some idea about what they could do with it.

"I told her, 'I guess we're having steak tonight instead of hamburger,'" he said.
