COVID-19

Many challenges have come up recently that we are all working through in both our personal and professional lives. The elephant in the room is COVID-19. Along with other state agencies we are working to ensure that we flatten the curve of community spread cases and protect our players and retailers.

When it comes to buying tickets, we are recommending that our players exercise caution. Players who play Lotto regularly, should consider reducing their number of trips to retailers by purchasing multi-draws. Players can also redeem winning tickets of up to \$19,999 by mail.

We are also seeing an impact on Powerball sales. With many places across the country going into shelter-in-place orders, sales have drop substantially. In order to protect the game, the Powerball consortium took measures that include reducing the starting jackpot to \$20 million and guaranteeing the jackpot will grow by \$2 million each draw that it isn't won. Powerball is a game in which the jackpot is predicated on sales, and lower sales means that jackpot increases of \$10 million may not be possible.

The outbreak of COVID-19 is a rapidly changing situation and we will continue to follow the advice of experts in how we conduct business.

Nebraska's Lotto Game Going Strong After 25 Years

On April 24, 1995, a new Nebraska Lottery Lotto game was launched. Known as "Nebraska's Game", all the proceeds from Nebraska Pick 5 stay here, and all the winning tickets are sold at Nebraska Lottery retailers. And after 25 years, Nebraska Pick 5 continues to give away thousands of dollars to players and generate funds for good causes in our state.



The first player to win a Nebraska Pick 5 jackpot was Linda Babcock of Maxwell. She purchased a \$30,000 winning ticket at Kwik-Stop in North Platte. Over 700 players have won the Pick 5 jackpot to date.

Some jackpot winners have more difficulty claiming their prize than others. On Thursday, November 7, 1996, Veronica Jane Olgesby of Omaha bought a Nebraska Pick 5 ticket from the Convenient Food Mart at 2014 L Street for what she thought was the Thursday night drawing. Her ticket was actually for the Friday night drawing. After checking the Wednesday night winning numbers, she threw her ticket away and purchased another using the same numbers. Saturday morning store manager Tom Brazil noticed that two \$30,000 winning tickets were sold at his store. Remembering that Veronica had thrown a ticket away, Brazil went dumpster diving, found the ticket, and returned it to her. The David Letterman Show asked Brazil to appear on the show. "No thank you," he replied. "I couldn't keep it. That's the way I was brought up."

Nebraska Pick 5 has undergone several changes over the years. Currently, the jackpot starts at \$50,000 and grows by \$4,000 every time it is not won. With drawings every day, Nebraskans have the chance to dream about winning all week long. Recent winner Richard Beran of Lexington had his heart set on buying a new Mustang with the \$82,000 prize he won in November 2019. But his wife had something more practical in mind. "I wanted a Mustang, but my wife wants a Jeep," he said.

We can't wait to share all the great stories from Nebraska Pick 5 winners over the next 25 years.

A majority of retailers use satellite communications for the Altura lottery terminal. Modifications, such as roof work, that will require the satellite dish to be relocated will involve some downtime. To shorten or avoid this downtime, please contact the Lottery Retailer Hotline (800-560-2919) at least one week in advance to ensure that Field Service Technicians will be available to temporarily remove or relocate equipment.

And Nebraska Lottery Operations

As the coronavirus (COVID-19) begins to affect Nebraskans, the Nebraska Lottery is monitoring the situation closely. We put the safety of our customers, retailers and staff first. During this ever-changing time, we want everyone to be aware of how we are responding to the COVID-19 situation.

- Nebraska Lottery participation in public events is cancelled until further notice.
- The Regional Lottery Claim Centers in Grand Island, Norfolk, North Platte, and Scottsbluff are closed to the public until further notice. Nebraska Lottery headquarters in Lincoln and the Omaha Claim Center remain open, but office hours may be adjusted as more information becomes available. Call 402-471-6100 to confirm office hours before claiming a prize in person.
- We encourage players with prizes up to \$19,999 to claim by mail. Claiming by mail is secure and our staff will work to process mailed claims in a timely manner.
- Lottery drawings will continue as scheduled. The Powerball Product Group has modified the game to offer a starting \$20 million annuity jackpot with minimum roll increases of \$2 million between drawings. The Powerball jackpot amount is based on ticket sales, and since the current health emergency has decreased sales nationwide, jackpot levels had to be adjusted. The Group will determine how long this change will last. See nelottery.com for more information.

We will continue to monitor the COVID-19 situation and will send updates via terminal message, on nelottery.com and our social media channels.

Contact Lottery Security After a Loss

Experiencing a theft at your store is never pleasant. If you have a loss that includes lottery tickets, make sure to contact Lottery Security after reporting the incident to local law enforcement. Nebraska Lottery tickets are one of the most trackable items in your store. Each ticket is individually barcoded, and scanning a ticket in the lottery terminal produces a record on the Lottery's central computer system.



Save Time

MULTI-DRAW

Did you know Lotto numbers can be purchased for up to 12 weeks of drawings with a multi-draw ticket? Multi-draws save time and ensure players never miss a drawing.

If you have regular players that purchase the same numbers every draw, you might suggest they buy multi-draw tickets. Multi-draw tickets can be purchased by checking one of the common draw selections on a play slip or by manual entry on the terminal.



Tuesdays are a great day for alliteration – Taco Tuesday, Trivia Tuesday and 2by2 Tuesday. Obviously, that last one has to do with our game 2by2 and the 2by2 Tuesday feature, though there are misconceptions about how that particular game works when Tuesday rolls around.

The misunderstanding concerning the 2by2 Tuesday feature is one that is simple to explain. Often, players will buy a 2by2 ticket on a Tuesday and believe that ticket is eligible for the 2by2 feature where all prizes double. However, to be eligible for the 2by2 feature, players need to purchase for 7 or more consecutive drawings as long as the draw selection is divisible by 7. That means multi-draws for 7, 14, 21, 28, 35, 42, 49, 56, 63, 70, 77 and 84 qualify for the 2by2 Tuesday feature.



RETAILER SPOTLIGHT



“They sold the lottery winner here,” a man getting out of a red pickup said. “The million dollar winner?” his wife asked.

Word travels fast when your store has a big winner. That’s certainly what happened at Schmick’s Market at 1340 W O Street in Lincoln after they sold a \$1 million Mega Millions winning ticket for the Tuesday, March 24 drawing.

Manager Scott Dunlap said it had only been announced by the Nebraska Lottery a few hours before, but a local TV news station mentioned the win on air and people were already showing up to ask about the big win.

“Word has spread very fast,” Dunlap said.

Dunlap said their store isn’t a high-volume lottery retailer, usually selling a few Scratch tickets here and there, but they’ve got their regulars who come in to buy Lotto.

Schmick’s Market employees found out about the win first thing Wednesday morning when two Nebraska Lottery investigators showed up to talk about the win and have Dunlap sign some verification paperwork. It wasn’t long after that that customers were showing up to find out if the news was true.

Things had been rough in the supermarket world for the last couple of weeks, Dunlap said, with the coronavirus spreading and customers coming in to stock up on pantry staples. It was nice to get a piece of good news, he said. While they hadn’t experienced an uptick in lottery sales yet that day, Dunlap said, they were expecting to once word has a chance to get around.

As for the winner, Dunlap said he wasn’t sure which employee sold the ticket—which was purchased on Friday, March 13—and they weren’t sure which customer it was, but they were pretty sure they’d figure it out eventually.

The \$1 million winner hadn’t come into the Nebraska Lottery Claim Office in Lincoln as of press time, but they still had a couple more draws to go on their multi-draw ticket.

“This has been pretty exciting,” Dunlap said. “It’s been a very pleasant surprise.”
