Building a Better Nebraska Since 1993

Did you know when someone buys a Nebraska Lottery ticket at your store, they're helping to build a better Nebraska? About 25 cents of every dollar spent on Lottery tickets goes back to our state. Here's how lottery proceeds are used:

Nebraska Environmental Trust (44.5%)

The Nebraska Environmental Trust provides grants to conserve, enhance, and restore the natural environments of Nebraska

Education as directed by the Legislature (44.5%)

Specific uses of lottery proceeds for education vary. The majority of the education proceeds (58%) are used for the Nebraska Opportunity Grant, the State of Nebraska's only need-based financial aid program for postsecondary students.

Nebraska State Fair (10%)

Lottery proceeds are used to upgrade and maintain facilities at the Nebraska State Fair. The most populous city within the county in which the fair is located must provide matching funds equal to 10% of the lottery proceeds transferred.

Problem Gambler's Assistance (\$500,000 plus 1% of remaining proceeds)

Lottery proceeds are used to operate the Problem Gambler's Assistance Hotline at 833-BETOVER (238-6837), and to provide free problem gambling treatment for Nebraskans and their families.

"Know Your Limit" reminders will appear on lottery materials replacing the previous "Play Responsibly" tagline. And a new microsite at **nelottery.com/knowyourlimit** has additional tips for setting time and budget limits.

Warning Signs of Problem Gambling

- **1.** You can't stop gambling, even when it's hurting you.
- 2. You bet money you can't afford to lose.
- 3. You bet other people's money.
- **4.** You steal to bet.
- **5.** Gambling is all you think about.
- **6.** Gambling is the main way you escape.
- 7. Asking others to bail you out when you've gambled money away.
- 8. Lying about the time and money you spend gambling.
- **9.** Gambling more after a loss to win back the loss.
- **10.** Gambling is killing your relationships.

It might be the most fun convenience store name to say out loud in all of Nebraska, but the Columbus mainstay is more than that.

Family-run since the 1980s, locals come in for Dickie Doodles' daily rotating menu of fresh hot food (including their famous sunrise burger), nearby residents stop to use the laundromat attached to the c-store and they were one of the first retailers in Nebraska to sell Lottery.

They also have merch, because who doesn't want a Dickie Doodles koozie or camo hat, you gotta get one of those.

Dickie Doodles is currently run by Chris and Lynette Dreifurst who have been the owners since 2007. They bought it from the original Dickie Doodle

himself, Dick James, who offered Chris the chance to buy it while he was filling up with gas at Dickie Doodles on his way to work one day.

Dickie Doodles is located right along Highway 30 on the eastern end of Columbus, with plenty of room for parking, making it a popular hot spot among truckers as well as locals and the folks who work at the multitude of manufacturing plants that surround the area.
