Millionaire for Life Launch

The new Millionaire for Life game launched on February 22 and is producing big prizes for Nebraskans. One week before the launch of the games, 20,000 coupons for free Millionaire for Life plays were randomly produced with Lucky for Life purchases. A total of 15,821 coupons were redeemed between February 22 and March 6, a redemption rate of 79%. And in the third Millionaire for Life drawing on February 24, one ticket sold at Pump & Pantry #42 at 1235 Allen Dr. in Grand Island matched four white ball numbers and the Millionaire Ball number for \$7,500.

Prepaid Debit Cards for Winners

One of the most frequent questions we get from players when we hand them the check for their win is "Where can I cash this?"

We know that there are Nebraska Lottery winners who are currently unbanked and what used to be a guessing game of which local bank would pay out their check has gotten a little easier.

Nebraska Lottery is now offering players who come to our headquarters to cash in a ticket an alternative to a physical check.

Wins of \$1,000 or less can now be paid with a US Bank Prepaid Debit Card with no fees and easy to use at nearly any retailer or ATM.

Memorial Day Bundle



Super C #2 Lincoln

For decades, Super C #2 in Lincoln has been the only spot for some commuters to stop for a quick coffee, gas or a Scratch ticket before work. The next convenience stores in either direction aren't for miles.

That's the way it's been since the shop opened in 1985. Smack dab at the corner of High Street and Highway 2. For over 40 years the shop has been helping Lincolniters get ready to face another day at work, but that store closed recently.

A brand new Super C store opened up next door, right in the shadow of the old store. The new store has about double the square footage without the tight aisles and checkout line bottlenecks of the old store.

Walking in, one thing's obvious, it smells really good in there.

A couple of years ago Super C acquired the Norm's on 48th convenience store and gas station and with it one of the best lunch options in Lincoln.

Ty's BBQ and Smashys used to be a well-kept South Lincoln secret, only open on certain days for lunch for a couple hours at a time. Word got out and more people were showing up for double-smash burgers and brisket every chance they could.

With the new Super C opening, Ty's is moving up in the world from their smokers and grills behind a gas station serving food from a tiny corner of a convenience store to a bright and modern kitchen where they have burgers and barbecue available all day along with a self-serve sauce bar. There's even a breakfast smashy burger if you're feeling the urge a little early.

The rest of the store is equally bright and shiny, with new flooring, wall covering and tile, it's a huge glow-up from the beige and white interior of the old store.

Lottery is a big seller at Super C #2 and with the new, extended counter with more registers than ever before, players can buy and redeem their winning tickets without holding up the line for people who haven't had their coffee yet.

With more room, their Scratch selection has expanded and there's a new side room for skill games.

For now, the old store sits empty (the gas pumps are still in service), right next to the new store. There will be some changes coming in the future, but for now, the Super C logo shines bright right next to the older logo.
