Where the Winners Are: Fact vs. Fiction

Ever heard a customer say, "No one wins in this town," or "All the winners are back east"? These are complaints we see on social media a lot, and in this issue of Ticket Talk, we'd like to debunk some common lottery winner myths.

MYTH: The lottery knows where the winners are and they place them at certain stores

FACT: No one at the Nebraska Lottery knows where winning Scratch and Lotto tickets will be sold. We don't predetermine where Scratch tickets are sent.

Every pack of Scratch tickets contains winning tickets. They're sent to retailers based on sales at each store. For example, when Truck\$ & Buck\$ launched this year, every retailer received Truck\$ tickets. Replacement ticket packs are sent on a first-come, first-served basis as tickets are sold, so every store carrying Truck\$ & Buck\$ has a chance to sell one of the seven truck-winning tickets.

MYTH: The winning tickets always end up in big cities.

FACT: Every Nebraska Lottery game has winning tickets, and the number of winners in any community is proportional to the number of tickets sold. As a very simple example, let's say one store sells five Scratch tickets and one ticket is a winner. Store two sells 10 Scratch tickets and has 2 winners. And store three sells 100 tickets and has 20 winners. Overall store three sold the most winning tickets – but it sold the same proportion of winning tickets to non-winning tickets as the other two stores.

Retailers that serve a large population of players may sell more tickets, but they're not guaranteed to sell the biggest prizes. For example, in July the two biggest Scratch winning tickets were sold in Grand Island and O'Neill – not Omaha or Lincoln.

On the Lotto side, you can purchase tickets in Scottsbluff and Omaha with exactly the same numbers, so your odds of winning are always the same no matter where you play.

MYTH: No one ever wins in my town.

FACT: Winning tickets can be sold at any store. We publish lists of winners regularly in The Lottery Times and our Annual Report. You might not have heard about a big win in your area if the winner asked us not to publicize it. However, a winner's name, hometown and prize amount is public information and will appear in the list of winners.

If we don't get permission for publicity from a winner, we have other ways to promote their win. Every month we create a map of retailers that have sold winning tickets of \$500 or more for public consumption. You can see the July winner map on our website at **nelottery.com/homeapp/winnermap**.

Winner awareness is an important part of the lottery business. People want to know there are winners in their community, and we want to tell great winner stories. We'll be working on new ways to highlight local winners at retail in the future, but if you have any suggestions for showcasing wins at your store, contact your LSR to discuss it.

In Nebraska, several activities were held during Lottery Week. A Lotto discount bundle was offered with one Nebraska Pick 5, MyDaY, and Nebraska Pick 3 play for \$2. The bundle was purchased 5,282 times at 671 retailers between July 15 and July 19. Because of the excellent response, additional terminal bundles will be offered in the future starting with a Labor Day special at the beginning of September.

Along with the discount ticket bundle, players could enter to win one of three lottery swag bags and assorted Scratch and Lotto tickets in the Lottery Week Social Media Giveaway. The prize was a definite draw for entrants. A total of 7,070 entries were received – the secondhighest number of entries ever in any Lottery social contest.

To close out Lottery Week, we asked players to help us choose the truck color for the 25th Anniversary of the Truck\$ & Buck\$ Scratch game next year. 639 votes were received on Facebook and Instagram, with the most votes received for the silver color.



RETAILER SPOTLIGHT

U-Stop Super Stone

The same day U-Stop celebrated its 60th birthday, the Lincoln-area chain of gas stations and convenience stores hit a new milestone, and became the first store in Nebraska with a dedicated Nebraska Lottery sales counter.

On August 1, the U-Stop at 110 West O Street in Lincoln opened up its first dedicated lottery counter. Featuring dozens of Scratch and Lotto options and custom signage, the Nebraska Lottery super store is the biggest of its kind in the entire state.

U-Stop celebrated the grand opening of the Nebraska Lottery super store with a party that included free food for customers, a radio remote from local country station Froggy 98 and games and prizes from the Nebraska Lottery. The lottery crew was out in force handing out free Scratch tickets to players and U-Stop crews were grilling hot dogs and handing out ice-cold pop to customers.

The West O U-Stop has quite a history with the Nebraska Lottery. Back in 2006, the store sold the \$365 million Powerball jackpot winning ticket to eight ConAgra employees. That's still a jackpot record for Nebraska and for a few years it held the title of world's largest lottery jackpot. Back in 2016, the store also sold a \$22,000 2by2

jackpot-winning ticket.

On August 4, just three days after they opened the new counter, the lottery super store sold a \$202,000 jackpot-winning Nebraska Pick 5 ticket. They're hoping the new counter will bring jackpot winners for MyDaY, Mega Millions and Lucky for Life, too.
